




Day 4: Session-II: Universal Human Values




Methodology of teaching this content is extremely important. It must not be through do's and don'ts, but by getting the students to explore and think by engaging them in a dialogue. It is



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best taught through group discussions, however with clarity of thought of the teachers cannot be overemphasized. It is essential for giving exposure, guiding thoughts and realizing values.




Day 6: Session-II: Universal Human Values

(Activity Coordinator: Dr. Mrs. A. K. Diwan)



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
The session presenter emphasized upon every human being to be a co-existence of one's self and body. The necessity of satisfying one's self is primarily important is the major takeaway from this session.
