The following points were discussed

- The IQAC chairman welcomed the members of IQAC and informed about various activities in college.
- The coordinator of IQAC presented the updated data for the 1st Semester of the academic year 2019 – 2020, from July 2019 to December 2019 to the committee.

- Dr. Deshpande and Dr. Gaikwad expressed satisfaction on overall progress of different academic, curricular and extra-curricular activities of the departments. Suggestions for quality improvement in some of the departments are given.
- Dr. Deshpande suggested to the HoD (IT) and HOD (Computer Engineering) to develop
 a software for girls' hostel, and suggested to the HoD (Civil Engineering) to plan for a
 model on water harvesting on the campus with the help of students projects.
- Dr. Gaikwad critically looked at the college data and commented that, SCOE being a
 flagship institute of STES has a major role in promoting quality improvement initiatives
 so that it will become a role model and guide to other colleges under the umbrella of
 STES.
- Highlights of Dr. Gaikwad's comments are as below:
 - a) Being a leading institute, enhanced performance and quality initiatives are expected from the college.
 - b) The feedback from stake holders play an important role in overall growth of the institute. Among different stake holders, the employer's feedback has highest weightage followed by alumni, parents, students and teachers. The institute should have a closed loop mechanism for feedback analysis and action taken.
 - c) Every student at SE, TE and BE shall be encouraged to take at least one value addition program in a year. The program can be completed either by online or offline with proper certification.
 - d) Industry assisted projects and internships should ideally reach 100%, for which every faculty member is expected to develop association with at least one industry.
 - e) Students should be encouraged to become members of professional bodies.
 - f) The results of SE, TE and BE need to be improved. To start with, every department should plan a target for all clear result percentage of students in the range of >65%, >75-80%, almost 100% for SE, TE and BE respectively. In order to achieve this target, the HoD shall ensure that, each subject teacher will set a target for result improvement as compared to previous semester.
 - g) The placement and higher studies information should account for about 80% of the students. A mechanism shall be at place with the Training and Placement department for continuous update of the status in this regard.

- h) Since the institute has PG and Ph.D. programs, the departments shall form a committee of senior faculty members to identify the potential projects for patent filing and the college should support this activity.
- i) The faculty shall be encouraged to further enhance their knowledge by way of certification from NPTEL and other e-resources on latest domain areas.
- j) Record checking of the data presented will be conducted before the end of the term.
- IQAC Chairman has positively addressed the comments and suggested to set up targets 1/0.5 per faculty for workshops-seminars/FDPs and paper publication or patent filing.
 Internship target for students could be atleast 50% of the batch. A structured mechanism for setting and achieving targets will be evolved.
